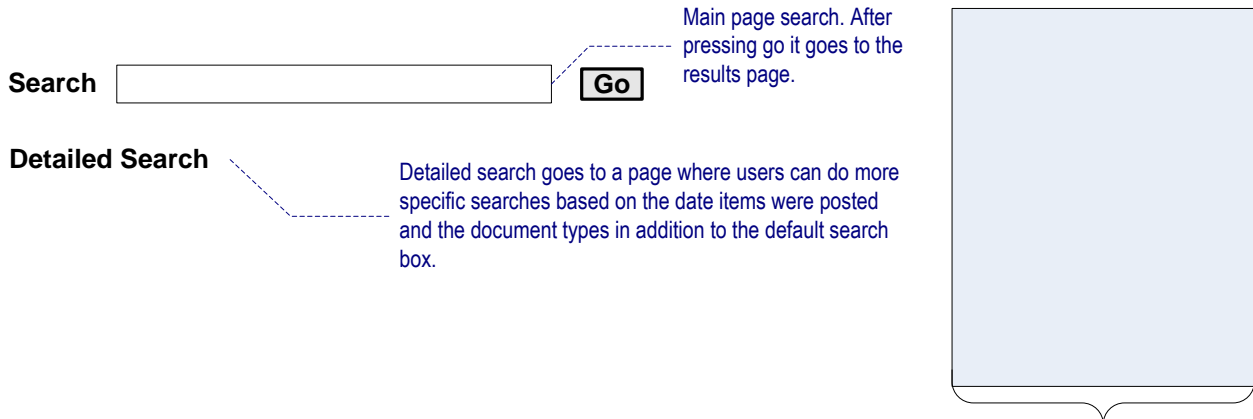

The above area is a text area introducing History Places web site.

Users come to this site to search for and add places to share with other enthusiast. The idea is to be able to see how places change over time.

Links on the navigation pane and their descriptions:

- Log in** - Log in so users can enter a profile to store favorites, follow discussions, rate pictures, etc.
- Browse by location** - Browse places by different methods such as location, favorites, era, etc. This link takes the user to a page where other predefine searches already exist. The sub-links under this link take the user to the results instead of to the browsing page.
- Communities** - This link goes to a page where users can join discussion groups about the different places, users can post messages, rate pictures and learn from others about different places.
- Favorites** - Goes to the favorites places or search results of the user. The user must be logged in in order to navigate to this page. If the user is not logged in, it goes to the log in page.
- Help** - Opens up another window with help information, including and FAQ

Places

The results are organized by places, there isn't an explicit place category, the individual documents are there primarily as a way to recognize what the places are (since they don't have names). Users will only be able to add a new item after running a search to find which is the group that their place belongs to, if there isn't one, they'll be able to create a new place by adding a new item.

There are two different sorting operations and each has its own weighting algorithm—one for places (rows) and one for documents within a place (items in a row). Each is based on term frequency and position, and on document ratings. For the document sort (within a place), each document stands on its own. For the place sort, each place is judged on the aggregation of these statistics for all of the documents within it.

A user can add a new place if none of the above places match what s/he is looking for

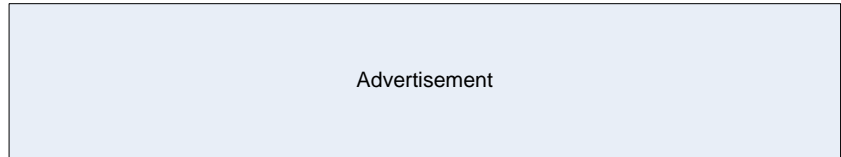

Detailed search



Search:

Go button to start the search; goes to results and if there is one place result, goes to the results2 page.

Keyword or phrase search. The search engine has a smart selection algorithm that helps determine when a query has a date element. For example if the user entered a series of 4 numbers a space and another 4 numbers, it could be a date range.

These are filters to search for specific types of documents. All are checked by default so the search results return all types of documents stored in the system. If a user wants to search only for audio, then s/he would uncheck the other options.

Date taken from: to:

An additional Go button to start the search for when the user fills more than just the keyword field

User may enter the complete date or only the years; month and date are not required fields. To search for a unique date the user would enter the same date on the from and to fields.

For audio and text, a larger version of the generic icon for that type is shown.

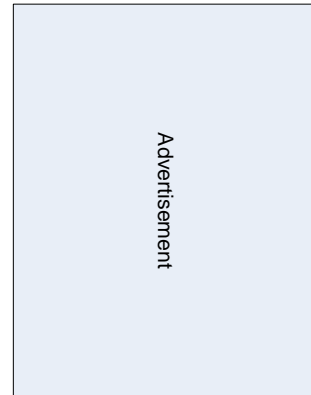
